- Students must be recommended by 2 members of Blair faculty
- Students must pay a \$3.00 membership fee each year to keep their membership current
- Students must pay a portion of the yearly NAHS membership fee (cost determined by current number of students)
- Students must maintain minimum 2.0 grade point average

Participating students will be accepted on probation into the National Art Honor Society provided they have met the above requirements, Students who meet the following requirements will be recognized and inducted in May as active members and will be eligible for pins, scholarships and/or special awards.

REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUCTION ARE:

- Maintain 3.0 Art scholarship

- Participation in fundraising activities
