Course Description:

Students study the works of contemporary potters and sculptors in terms of form, finish, and conceptual statement. Students create a series of forms that reflect a common source or theme. They combine hand-made and wheel-thrown clay forms to create artworks that reflect personal meaning. Kiln theory is developed as students learn to stack and monitor the kiln. A variety of surface decoration techniques are applied to artworks. Craftsmanship, efficiency and safe studio practices are emphasized.

- Final projects and exams may not be retaught or reassessed.
- Sketches and the last assignment of the quarter can not be reassessed.
